
2023 Steinert & Ferreiro Award Nomination Guide

The History

Since 2005, the Steinert & Ferreiro Award has been Canada's premiere recognition of leadership in the 2SLGBTQ+ community.

Funded by a bequest made through the estates of Jonathan R. Steinert and Fernando Gumercindo Ferreiro, who passed away in 1990 and 1992, respectively.

As part of a legacy for him and his late partner, Mr. Ferreiro wished to recognize and honour individuals who made a significant contribution in arts and sciences to increase the understanding and acceptance of the 2SLGBTQ+ community. Mr. Ferreiro chose the Lesbian and Gay Community Appeal - now Community One Foundation - to carry out his wishes.

At the heart of this award is inspired leadership and selfless contributions to the 2SLGBTQ+ community. Many nominees are often working quietly to achieve growth, understanding and change, and Community One Foundation is proud to present The Steinert & Ferreiro Award to celebrate these unsung heroes of our community.

The Award Presentation and Eligibility



Presentation

The presentation includes a commemorative award and \$10,000 cash prize.

The recipient must accept the award in-person and be publicly acknowledged for their contribution. Signing the nomination form indicates this agreement.

The 2023 Steinert & Ferreiro Award will be given out at the Canadian LGBT+ Chamber of Commerce annual Black & White Gala on November 10, 2023.

Eligibility

Any individual who has contributed significantly to the arts and sciences in the Greater Toronto Area to promote understanding and acceptance for the 2SLGBTQ+ community is eligible for nomination. The arts and sciences may include the humanities (e.g. literature, philosophy, community engagement & activism), social sciences (e.g. law, psychology, politics, history, community and social work), fine arts (e.g. music, theatre, film), and physical sciences (e.g. engineering, biology, medicine).

Nomination Instructions

- 1. Complete the nomination form, including signatures from the Nominee and all Nominators. Nominators can be any individual with a connection to the nominee's work and contributions.
- 2. Submit a 1,000-2,000 word letter outlining the individual's accomplishments and significant contributions to the 2SLGBTQ+ community. Have this letter signed by three people associated with the nominee's work and contributions (can be the above-mentioned nominators, but are not required to be).
- 3. Gather 2-4 letters supporting this application from other individuals or organizations that are acquainted with the nominee's work and contributions.
- 4. Send the completed nomination package in one email, including nomination form & support letters and send to sfaward@communityone.ca with the nominee's name in the subject line.

Nomination Deadline

All submissions must be received by 5p.m. EST Monday, October 16, 2022.
